Our online and in-person trainings have enhanced the capacity of thousands of teachers, health workers, local leaders, and government officers to lead on public health initiatives. As our work continues to grow in new areas, we are looking for the right candidate to grow with us and increase the depth and scope of our efforts.

About NALA

NALA is an internationally recognized expert in the fight to eliminate neglected tropical diseases (NTDs). NTDs impact more than 1.5 billion people worldwide, disproportionately affecting rural and high-poverty populations with the least access to clean water and sanitation. Our innovative and community-based solutions have led to a sustainable reduction in the burden of disease in project areas. Our model complements drug administration campaigns with a focus on promoting healthy behavior change, strengthening the capacity of the local community to improve public health, and increasing their access to water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH).

About the Position

This position is 60% with an initial 3-month probationary period and the potential to grow to full-time. The selected candidate will join the NALA team at our headquarters in Tel Aviv. Reporting to the Head of Learning, the Learning & Impact Officer (LIO) will support the design and development of materials and tools to be used in our projects. They will also support the team in researching novel strategies and technologies that could further enhance our work. The role also includes data entry and visualization to contribute to building an organizational culture that utilizes learning to harness best practices and deliver meaningful impacts.

Responsibilities

1. Write, edit, and review content for education and training purposes that will be delivered to a wide range of target groups, from early childhood to adult community members.
2. Design (or support the design) of graphics, artwork, and teaching aids.
3. Research and identify opportunities to increase organization's impact through new methodologies, strategies, and tools.
4. Use data and research to measure our impact and support the development of best practices.
5. Participate in needs assessments to identify challenges and gaps, with special attention to learning environments and inclusion.

6. Communicate with and support other staff involved in learning activities, including professional development and monitoring & evaluation.
7. Contribute to the overall activities of the team as needed.
8. Ensure accurate reporting, timely updates, and briefings to senior staff.

1. *Exceptional writing and editing skills*- Extremely strong English writing and editing skills. Ability to write diverse types of materials, including lesson plans and reports.
2. *Attention to detail*- An eye for format, design, and accuracy.

Qualifications
